



## Warehouse Assistant (2)

**Location:** Kingston, Ontario. On-site at our warehouse and various program locations.

**Who We Are:** With the unstoppable force of lionhearted partners and volunteers, we at Lionhearts eradicate hunger and homelessness, restoring dignity and hope in the communities we serve. Since our founding in 2014, we have committed to serving our communities through acts of practical love that restore human dignity – from rescuing food and household goods, to operating warming shelters and supportive housing, retraining people to help rebuild their lives, and much more.

**Position:** Lionhearts is seeking a motivated and organized Warehouse Assistant to join our team. Working closely with the Warehouse Manager, warehouse staff, and volunteers, the successful candidate will play a key role in the day-to-day logistics functions of our organization. The Warehouse and Program Assistant will work collaboratively with the team to ensure the efficient and safe operation of the warehouse and program activities. The role involves driving delivery vehicles, maintaining supplies, organizing food supplies, and supporting various program-related tasks.

This position is being advertised under the Canada Summer Jobs (CSJ) program. Applicants must be

- between 15 and 30 years of age (inclusive) at the start of employment;
- registered as a full-time student during the preceding academic year;
- intending to return to school on a full-time basis during the next academic year;
- a student in a secondary, post-secondary, vocational or technical program;
- a Canadian Citizen, permanent resident, or person on whom refugee protection has been conferred under the “Immigration and Refugee Protection Act” and;
- legally entitled to work according to the relevant provincial/territorial legislation

Applicants must also possess a valid Social Insurance Number at the start of employment.

### **Responsibilities:**

- Load and unload delivery vehicles as needed
- Perform regular vehicle inspections and cleaning
- Maintain supplies and inform the warehouse supervisor of low inventory
- Perform general housekeeping to keep areas clean and orderly
- Assist with inventory management for the Student Food Box and Warehouse
- Organize and store food supplies appropriately
- Facilitate volunteer sessions when required
- Ensure all assigned duties are completed in a safe, efficient, and productive manner
- Safely drive delivery vehicles for the transportation of food donations and meal packages
- Other duties as assigned

### **Requirements:**

- Ability to stand for extended periods



- Ability to perform heavy lifting (up to 40 kg) and bending
- Ability to work in a fast-paced environment
- Team player with excellent organizational and time management skills
- Proficient in Excel and Email
- Flexibility in scheduling, including weekends and split shifts
- Effective communication skills
- First Aid & CPR training (an asset)
- Safe Food Handlers and Rescue Certification (will be provided)
- G2 or G Licensed Driver with Clean Drivers Abstract (preferred)

**Wage:** \$19.50/hour

**Term:** Temporary, Full-time, 40 hours/week, 8-week term. The position may require flexibility in work hours, including weekends and split shifts.
